"The following BHPA (British Hang Gliding and Paragliding Association) Safety Advisory notice addresses a safety issue that could cause serious neck injury to HG pilots of high aspect ratio HG wings..."

- BHPA (British Hang Gliding / Paragliding Assoc) - Safety Advisory

In summary the notice;

- Brings notice that high aspect ratio wings may whack a Pilot in the back of the head / neck if he / she swings through before the wing in the event of a base-bar crash.
- Reinforces the standard "hands on uprights" landing approach.
