Passing of Alexandar Blanch in a Weightshift Microlight Aircraft Accident, NSW.

It is with great sadness, that we advise of the passing of Alexandar Blanch, a well-respected weightshift microlight pilot and member of the Sports Aviation Federation of Australia.

Alexandar tragically died in a weightshift microlight accident while flying near Maitland in NSW on 30th November 2019. His passenger also tragically died in the accident.

SAFA Operations and local Police investigations were immediately mobilised and are now assisting Coronial authorities.

It is too early to determine the cause of the accident and until the investigation is complete, we cannot comment. A comprehensive investigation is now underway.

Members will understand that this process will take some time before firm conclusions can be made and findings shared.

Our thoughts and sincere condolences are with Alexandar's family and the local flying community during this very sad time.
